Dear Parents/Carers,

Financial support by parents has always played a significant role in providing resources that extend the school's capacity to add value to the learning experiences of students. The continuing partnership between schools and parents is vital to ensuring that all students receive a level of education sufficient to enable them to have success in today's society. The Margaret River Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of contributions and charges for 2023 under section 108 of the School Education Act 1999. The schedule is broken into sections which will allow you to ascertain costs for the year.

Certain items may not be required if retained from previous years. It also may be necessary to replace some items such as pencils throughout the year.

All schools, including MRPS, offer other services that incur costs but are not directly related to educational costs such as school uniforms, school photos, book club, and charitable collections (free dress days). These costs have not been added to our calculations.

The school has its own EFTPOS/Credit card facilities and payment can be made at the front office at any time or via internet banking.
